

BUILDING A EUROPEAN AREA FOR VET AND APPRENTICESHIPS

Created by the main French networks in Vocational Education and Training (VET) in 2020, **Euro App Mobility** seeks to give **VET learners and apprentices** the same **international learning opportunities** as students in Higher Education.

Led by its founder, former Minister and Member of the European Parliament, Jean Arthuis, it promotes the construction of a **European Area** of VET and Apprenticeships. Together with other VET stakeholders, it promotes the integration of learning mobility in apprenticeships, notably through **Erasmus+**.

In addition to the contributions of its members, EAM is funded by the French Ministry of Labour, the General Secretariat for Investments for the Future, and the European Union through the ESF+.

EAM is based in Paris and Brussels. Our team of ten people closely cooperates with national and European public authorities and supports VET providers, employers and other actors of learning mobility.

OUR INITIATIVES

1. Develop long-term apprentice mobility

The national pilot project "MONA" develops methods to integrate mobilities of at least two months in apprenticeship programmes. It aims to develop practical solutions to overcome barriers.

2. Train mobility coordinators

MOBLT is a training programme developed by major VET networks and the French Erasmus+ agency. It equips staff of VET providers with the necessary skills to develop mobility.

3. Cooperate with European stakeholders

The European Coalition for Apprentice Mobility brings together eleven mobility support bodies from eight EU member states. It fosters operational and institutional cooperation.

4. Enhance the involvement of employers

The Club of Employers for Apprenticeships in Europe seeks to enhance the involvement of employers. It promotes apprentice mobility for skills development and employability.
